

Privacy Policy

Welcome

Welcome to the Sea Power Ambassador web site! This Privacy Statement is designed to tell you about our practices regarding collection, use, and disclosure of information that you may provide via this web site. Please be sure to read this entire Privacy Statement before using, or submitting information, to this web site. In this Privacy Statement, we address some common questions and concerns that you may have about using this web site:

Who operates this web site?

The web site is owned and operated by the American Shipbuilding Association (ASA).

What information do you collect from me when I use this web site?

We collect two kinds of information from you: non-personal information and personal information.

Non-personal information is information we collect through this web site that does not identify you as an individual person. It may include information like the type of web browser software you use, the pages you have visited and date and time you accessed our pages, and personal information that has been de-identified.

Personal information is information we collect through this web site that we can use to specifically identify you, and may include your name, telephone number and e-mail address

How do you collect information on this web site?

We collect non-personal information from your computer's web browser. In addition, we may also place a text file called a cookie in the browser files of your computer when you visit. A cookie is a numeric code that a web site transfers to your hard drive for record keeping purposes. Our cookie does not collect your name, e-mail address or any other personal information about you. Our cookie will enable us to recognize you when you return to this web site for future visits and may help us provide you with personalized content. Your browser software can be set to reject cookies, including the cookie from our web site. However, please note that if you reject our cookies, you may not be able to use this web site. We collect personal information from you when you voluntarily share it with us, such as when you reply to an email message or use one of our other online forms.

How do you keep and use personal information you collect from me through this web site?

We may keep and use personal information we collect from you through this web site to provide you with access to this web site and send you information via email. In addition, we may keep and use your personal information: to respond to your requests to contact you with information that might be of interest to you, for analytical purposes and to research, and to develop and improve programs, services and content to remove your personal identifiers (your name, e-mail address, email address, etc).

Do you share my personal information with third parties? If so, who?

We will not share your personal information collected from this web site with an unrelated third party without your permission, except as otherwise provided in this Privacy Statement. In the ordinary course of business, we will share

some personal information with companies that we hire to perform services or functions on our behalf. In these cases, we provide the vendor with information to process your order such as your name and mailing address. In all cases in which we share your personal information with a third party, we will not authorize them to keep, disclose or use your information with others except for the purpose of providing the services we asked them to provide.

We may be legally compelled to release your personal information in response to a court order, subpoena, search warrant, law or regulation. We may cooperate with law enforcement authorities in investigating and prosecuting web site users who violate our rules or engage in behavior which is harmful (or illegal) to other users. We also may disclose your personal information to third parties if we feel that the disclosure is necessary to: enforce this Privacy Statement and the other rules about your use of this web site protect our rights or property protect someone's health, safety or welfare comply with a law or regulation, court order or other legal process

Is my personal information safe from unauthorized access?

Please remember that while we take steps to protect the privacy of the information you send to us on this web site, we cannot guarantee your message is protected against unauthorized interception. In particular, e-mail sent to or from this site may not be secure and you should therefore take special care in deciding what information you send us via e-mail.

Do you have any special rules about protecting the privacy of children?

We will not intentionally collect any personal information (such as a child's name or e-mail address) from children under the age of 13. Does this Privacy Statement still apply if I follow a link from this web site to another web site?

This Privacy Statement does not apply to any other web site, even the other the Sea Power Ambassador website.
